### WIKIMEDIA

The term "Wikimedia" is used to describe a global movement to bring free educational content to the world, of which Wikipedia is but one part. Prominent Wikimedia projects in the community include **Commons** for multimedia, **Wiktionary** as free dictionary and **Wikidata** for structured data.

#### WIKIMEDIA FOUNDATION

The foundation is a nonprofit charitable organization for "encouraging the growth, development and distribution of free, multilingual, educational content... to the public free of charge." It oversees fundraising, operation of computing

infrastructure and development of sofware for Wikipedia and its related projects.

Ward Cunningham, was on his
honeymoon in Hawaii when he
saw airport shuttle buses using
the Hawaiian word for quick, "WIKI
WIKI." When he created software
that allowed for people to edit pages
quickly and easily, he borrowed the
term for his project.
