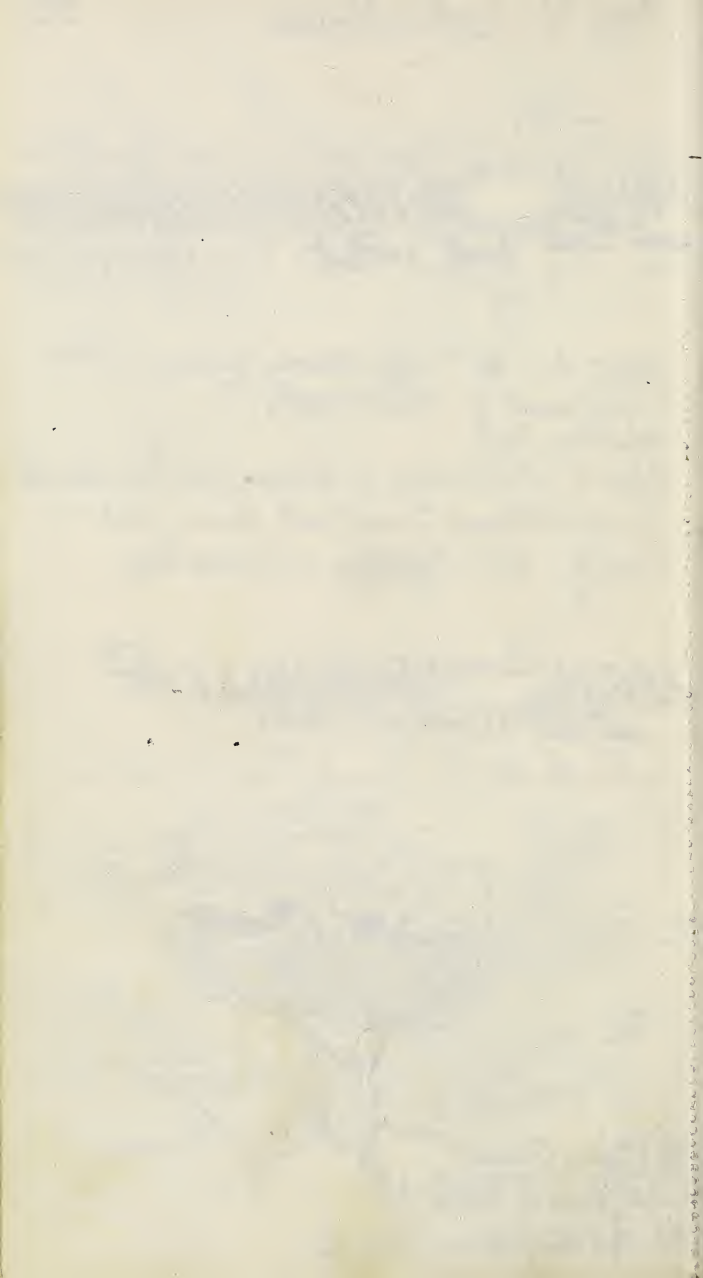




1. above A - B Ruffs densely matted (like a pavement of white mounds!)

5. Close by - W.T. Lapwing & Scissor-bills



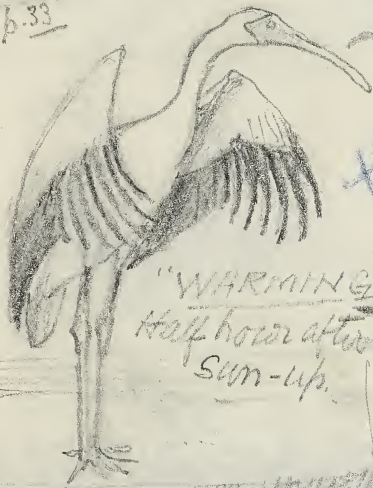
