

# АДМИНИСТРАТИВНА КАРТА НА ПИРИНСКА МАКЕДОНИЈА

# ПАЗАРЦИКСКА ОБЛАСТ

This administrative map illustrates the Pirin Mountain region in Bulgaria, spanning across several provinces. The map shows the following regions and their boundaries:

- Општина Разлог** (Razlog) in the center-north.
- Општина Горна Цумаја** (Gorna Tzumaya) in the northwest.
- Општина Кресна** (Kresna) in the west.
- Општина Струмјани** (Strumjani) in the west.
- Општина Петрич** (Petrich) in the southwest.

Major rivers shown include the **Струма** (Struma), **Балканска река** (Balkan River), **Доспатско езеро** (Dospat Lake), **Езеро Батак** (Batash Lake), **Езеро Белемекен** (Belmekan Lake), and **Езеро Бели Искар** (Beli Iskar Lake).

A note indicates that the area around **Селово** is part of Pirin Mountain but administratively belongs to Kustendil Province.
