


WikiFundi is ...

... the offline editing environment that mimics the experience of editing Wikipedia to navigate context-specific challenges, and encourages a bridging experience and space for training, creation and collaboration.



Each dot represents a geotagged article on WikiData



66% of world uses the internet ... less than 20% in Africa





More edits originate from Hong Kong each quarter than do from the entire continent of Africa over the same period.

There are, on average, 100 times more geotagged articles on France than in Africa.

Why it matters what is on Wikipedia

When looking on the internet, what do the ½ billion people across Africa below the age of 18 see about themselves? very little.












How WikiFundi gets Africa's knowledge onto Wikipedia


- Build a culture of contribution to the internet

 - Develop the technical and editorial skills to add content on local subjects to Wikipedia
 - Know that their knowledge is valuable and valued.


