Files that will be eligible for prizes

- Photos of places where Tamils live, Photos of Tamils and people related to Tamil studies
- Photos of Tamil heritage symbols, Tamil institutions, Species (plants and animals) in Tamil livingspaces
- Photos of Tamil heritage places, temples, places of worship, buildings etc
- Educational resources in Tamil; Files that can be used for teaching in Tamil - Maps, graphs, illustrations, diagrams, charts, audio and video files that contain explanation in
- Pronunciation files for Tamil words and phrases. Audio recordings of Tamil literary works
- Audio and Video recordings of Tamil cultural practices, arts, dances, sports
