

(REGISTERED) SIMPLE FOOT MEASUREMENT SYSTEM

For Ladies, Gentlemen and Children.

With an ordinary tape-measure determine the width around the foot A A, around the lower ball, round level of heel and D, next ascertain the length and width of tread by placing the foot on a sheet of paper, and drawing a lead pencil around the heel and toe. Cut the outline thus made up to the suture, and compare with the other measurements. Determine what size you generally take, what are your peculiarities—a weak ankle, perhaps a pet corn, ingrowing nails, or a bloom on the foot, all these little matters I take into account, and you are sure to get a fit. If you have a long thin foot, or a short thick one, with very high instep, send to ELLIS'S, where you are sure to get a fit.
