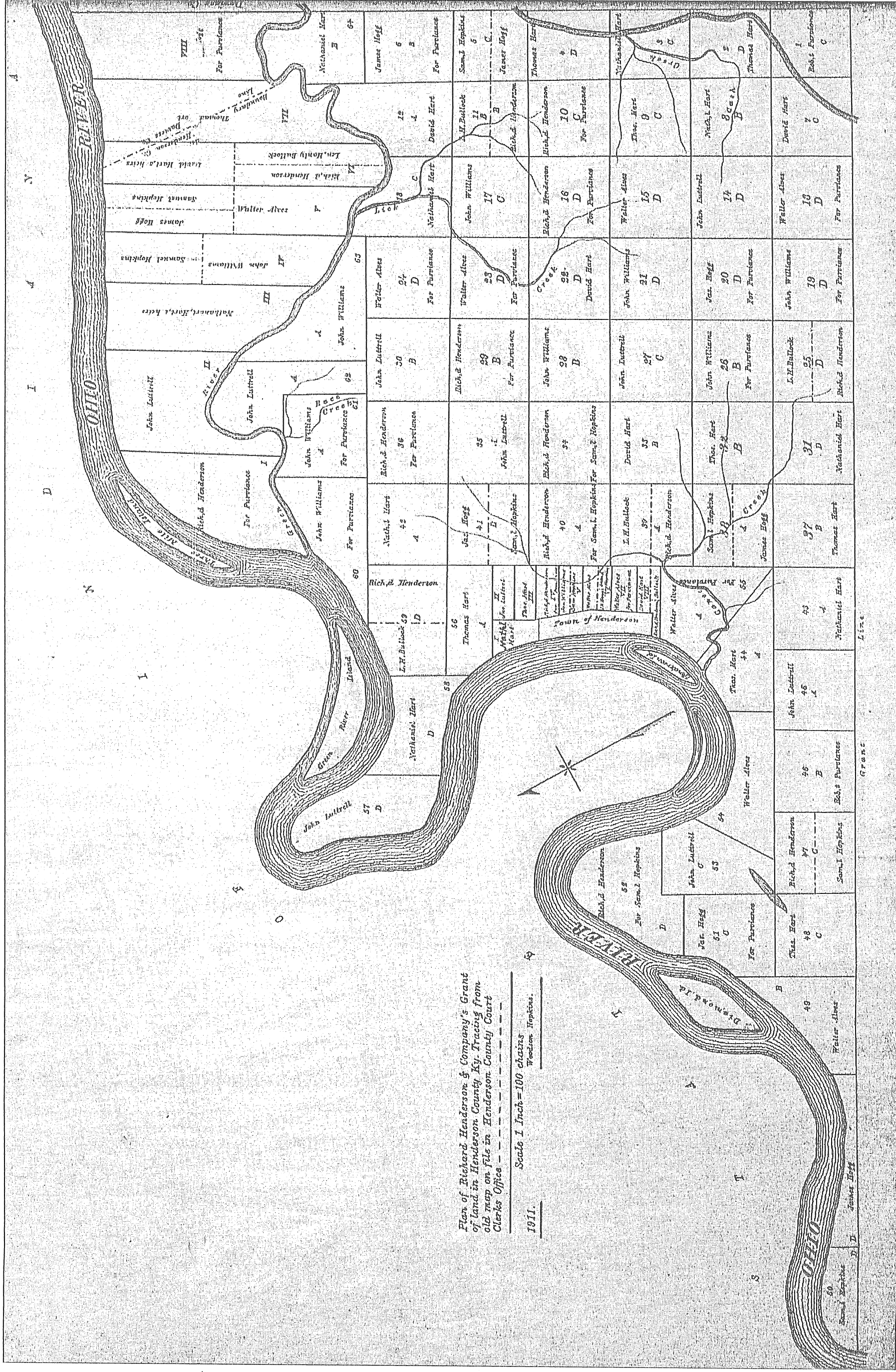


The land grant that became Henderson County



▲ In 1778, Virginia's legislature voided Richard Henderson and Co.'s purchase of vast lands from the Cherokee, but compensated the investors by granting them this land where the Ohio and Green rivers meet.
