THE LONG SAULT PARKWAY
 The rising waters will totally inundate a large acreage along the whole waterfront. This submersion will create a total of 18 new islands. The Ontario-St. Lawrence Development Commission has undertaken a scenic drive connecting a number of these islands with the mainland highway system. This road is to be known as the Long Sault Parkway, commemorating the famous Long Sault rapids which will disappear.
