Exclusion criteria for the allocation of scholarships

The decision to allocate the scholarships is made by the jury. However, some criteria result in direct exclusion from the allocation of a scholarship:

- 1. Not eligible for grants / volunteer support from Wikimedia Deutschland, e.g. due to *Fördersperre* (support ban).
- 2. Globally blocked / banned by the Wikimedia Foundation or the community; event banned by the Wikimedia Foundation.
- 3. Violation of the scholarship agreement in previous years, e.g. received a scholarship in 2023 or 2024 but did not complete the post-conference report(s) within the agreed period.
- 4. International application without a German tandem partner or without a submitted application from the potential German tandem partner.
- 5. Members of the WMDE scholarship jury for the allocation of the participation scholarships for Wikimania 2025.
- 6. Minors in Germany: under 18 years of age who would be traveling <u>without</u> a parent or legal guardian. (Travel costs for a parent or legal guardian are not covered by the scholarship.)
